Important points should be noted:

1. Margine 2.5 cm, all four sides.
2. Title should be provided (not more than 40 charaters)
3. Abstract should be provided word limit i. e. 150 words for case reports and 200 for original article
4. 3 to 10 keywords or short phrases that capture the main topics of the article. Key words should be arranged in alphabetical orders.

Language and grammar

Uniformity in the language .

Abbreviations spelt out in full for the first time

Font size: In title:14, In text: 12 i. e. in Times in Roman

Numerals at the beginning of the sentence spelt out

Use abbreviated form only after using its full form when it first appears in the text except abstract.

Tables

Tables should be numbered (with Arabic numerals) and each table should be typed on a separate sheet of paper. Tables should be self-explanatory and include a brief descriptive title. Footnotes to tables, indicated by lower case letters are accepted, but they should not include extensive experimental detail.

Figure

Figures should be numbered consecutively according to the order in which they have been first cited in the text.
